## Septic & Well Project Update

As many of you know, we have been dealing with a septic system that is well below the capacity needed for the home. The tanks have required expensive monthly visits from sanitation trucks to remove the waste water. A few months back we began to make plans to deal with the septic waste more appropriately and in a way that would cost less money.



The decision was made to install a proper septic drain field in the rear of the property, behind the main wall, and pump the water to that field.

The Lord began to immediately provide for this need. We are now happy and thankful to let you know that we are just about ready to begin the project!

We will also be drilling a deeper well. The original well on the property is only about 12 feet deep. As you can imagine, this water is not drinkable. While we have water filtration, the amount of contamination and volume of water needed wears heavily on equipment and filters. By digging a deeper well we will relieve some of this.

As mentioned, this project will help to reduce some of the growing financial stress we have been facing. By installing this system, we will save nearly \$1,000/month. We are quite excited for this, as it will help us to continue the basic operation of the ministry. Please pray that the Lord would continue to guide us in financial decisions.

## Prayer Requests

Please pray that the Lord would guide us in the right direction as we continue to seek a full-time couple to serve as House Parents.

Pray also that the Lord would continue to work through the team of believers from the the assembly in Bucharest that is sharing the Gospel with the girls each Sunday evening.

## New Board Members Added

At February's Board Meeting, several brothers were added to the Jubilee Association Board of Directors. Ioan "Nelu" Nica (also full-time administrator), Florian Ion, and Jonathan Schwarz were added to this group that oversees the ministry. Please be in prayer for this team as they seek God's wisdom for this work.

## Development Plans

The goal of the Jubilee Association is to provide an environment that serve the needs of these girls where we can share the Gospel with them. The basic need of most of the girls here is learning to live independently. This involves many new concepts for them. Among these are financial discipline and living on their own.



We now have plans to bring 5 modular living units to the Bolintin property. These units will each be able to house 2 of our girls. Girls that meet certain requirements (like holding a job, and meeting certain behavior guidelines) will be permitted to "rent" a unit with another girl rather than living in the main house communally. The modular units will be much nicer than what they have now, and will begin a 2 year process of transitioning them to a real apartment in the local towns.

We are thankful that the Lord has moved a group of believers to donate the modular units to us, and will come and work with the girls to help make this transition process a reality. Presently, we are looking at the end of the summer for this to become a reality.
