



"Liquidation" Completion - APRIL 1st!!!!

When Sue Bates created the Jubilee Association in 2007, her thought was to provide a successor organization for the InAsMuch Foundation that she and Ron faithfully had overseen for about 20 years. Unfortunately, she and Ron both passed away before she was able to complete the legal transfer of properties to the new organization she had created. After her passing, there was a very difficult time of adjustment and planning for the future.

During the summer of 2009 Jubilee petitioned the court to appoint a liquidator to transfer all of the properties. The judge agreed that this was appropriate and assigned a liquidator to comb through all the books and settle all matters that may show up in the InAsMuch Foundation. This process has taken nearly 9 months.

On April 1st, the judge is scheduled to do the final sign off on the liquidation, assigning all deeds to Jubilee. Currently the completed liquidation papers are posted for public review (a 1 month process that began at the end of February).

Please pray that:

1. There would be no claims against InAsMuch
2. There would be no delay in completing this process
3. God would provide for the deed transfer fees
4. Wisdom for the board as decisions are made for best usage of the facilities.
5. God would provide for the daily needs at Jubilee, both workers and finances.

We currently have 4 buildings. **The Bolintin Deal** property is where most of the young women are living either in the big house or, more independently, in one of four dual occupancy units provided by Blytheswood Care. **The Horia Street house** in Ciorogârla is a smaller house where Nelu and Vasi live and often provide room and board for visitors to Jubilee. Around the corner from the Horia house, is our **Gradinari Street house**, where a few more independent girls were living, but have now mostly moved on. Flore and her child, Briana, are living there right now. **The "Linco" house** is empty and unused. This house and the Gradinari house have been the focus of much discussion and prayer by the board.

Transportation Needs

Please pray with us that God would provide a couple of automobiles for Jubilee. Presently we are using an



Opal van on loan to us by a brother from Ireland who is part of Blytheswood Care. This is presently our only vehicle. Part of our work with the young women is encouraging them and assisting them in getting steady jobs so that they can move to independent living. To facilitate this, we are often driving them to and from work. Our guards have often done the driving with their own vehicles, but this is not always available. Often Nelu ends up having to drive them in the borrowed van.

We would like to purchase a van for Jubilee and perhaps a small efficient car for when we only have to transport 1-3 of the young women. It has been a blessing to use the van we have, but when it is broken down, we are left with few backup options. (Recently the timing chain on the van broke, and had to be replaced - along with several valves and other sundry parts.)

Please pray that the Lord would see to our transportation needs. Getting the girls to work for every shift is very important in helping them build a good employment record that will enable them to get better jobs and move into private apartments on their own.
